Jackson, MS- Today marks a special day for a local business, Buy From A Christian, LLC (the "Company"). This date marks the one-month anniversary of the official launch of its new website, BuyFromAChristian.com. The site was created for Christians who wish to buy and sell both products and services on a website specifically targeting the Christian community while celebrating Christian faith. The goal of the site is to meet specific needs in a specific population with a unique twist- the site promises to give 10% of all product and service listing fees from a user to his or her chosen church or organization. The concept is to encourage users to utilize a website that supports other Christians while contributing to the user's local church. Any user can upload his or her church to the site's database which enables this free listing to be viewed by all who visit the site.

This Mississippi company is gaining momentum. In just one month the site has users in seven states and more than 500 product listings. Philip Chustz, CEO of the company, said: "This site was created to be an e-commerce alternative for Christians. We want to be a website for everyday Christian use. We believe our slogan says it all as we try to create a 'Christ-Centered Commerce Community.'"

The site also features business listings for Christian businesses. The hope is to provide a place where Christians can shop, and then have the convenience of searching for Christian professionals in a wide variety of Christian businesses all on the same site. Chustz says, "For example, if you need a plumber, attorney, or tax specialist why not Buy >From A Christian?" The Company's listing charges are low, beginning at only \$2 a month to list a business and 25 cents per month to list a product.

A number of Mississippians are already supporting the site and its message. Miss Mississippi Taryn Foshee has a link to the site on her website. Several local businesses including Miskelly Furniture, Traditional Jewelers, and Doug Wilson Dodge have all purchased business listings on the site.

Bob Montgomery of Traditional Jewelers was the first business owner to list products on BuyFromAChristian.com. "It's about Christians supporting other Christians. I hope every Christian business owner supports this site."

The Company is most excited about a feature under development to be released soon. Described as a fundraising opportunity, this feature will allow church groups to host online "garage sales" using the website's product listing pages to reach Christian customers all over the country. Chustz states, "Imagine hosting a garage sale online, without the early morning trip to the local gym with all the logistic headaches and related setup pressures. Then imagine reaching potential buyers well outside your local market, while helping a site grow that celebrates Christianity and contributes to your local church or non-profit organization."

While early in its development, Chustz remains optimistic about the site's potential for providing a Christian E-commerce solution. "We are a unique site with a unique message and goal. We know our success rests not in the earthly hands of its founders, but in the hands of our Heavenly Father."
